

GOAL #1 - SERVICE

PSA2AAA will provide services for the benefit of older adults and adults with functional impairments as directed by the Older Americans Act and Older Californians Act which promote the ability to remain at home with maximum dignity, choice, and independence.

RATIONALE

Services provided under the Older Americans Act and Older Californians Act is essential to enable older adults and adults with functional impairments to remain independent and to prevent premature institutionalization.

OBJECTIVES

- A. The PSA2AAA will provide optimal services as directed under the Older Americans Act and Older Californians Act. These services include:
- Transportation (Access)
 - Legal Assistance
 - Information & Assistance (Access)
 - Outreach (Access)
 - Ombudsman
 - Congregate Nutrition
 - Home Delivered Meals
 - Nutrition Education
 - Disease Prevention and Health Promotion (targeting fall prevention and related minor home repairs)
 - Medication Management (provision of educational materials on adverse drug reactions and poly pharmacy to prevent incorrect medication)
 - Elder Abuse Prevention
 - Family Caregiver Support
 - Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Centers (two programs)
 - Brown Bag (two programs)
 - Linkages
 - Respite Purchase of Service
 - Senior Companion
 - Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP)

In addition to these services, the following services may be provided by PSA2AAA:

- Personal Care (In-Home)
- Homemaker (In-Home)
- Chore (In-Home)
- Adult Day/Health Care (In-Home)
- Case Management (Access)
- Assisted Transportation (Access)
- Other Supportive Services
- Nutrition Counseling
